Section 2: General Information

2.1 Purpose

The purpose of this RfQ is **the supply, print, and delivery of PVC Mesh Fabric for Hoarding Banners.**

2.2 Scope and Terms & Conditions

The rates for printed PVC Mesh Fabric shall be deemed to include the supply and **delivery to the Project Green offices at Avenue 77, Triq in-Negoju, Zone 3 Central Business District, Birkirkara CBD3010** of all materials, labour, plant, equipment, printing processes, handling, protection, packaging, transportation, and all ancillary items necessary for the proper execution and completion of the works as specified.

As part of the implementation of the project, Project Green (PG) requires the installation of printed artwork banners along the boundary fencing demarcating the construction area. The primary aim of these banners is to provide a cleaner and more visually organised hoarding treatment to the project site, whilst simultaneously disseminating information related to the project to third parties and passers-by. The banners shall also serve as advertisement and branding media for the project.

The Contractor shall supply and deliver to Project Green offices printed PVC Mesh Fabric intended to serve both as hoarding screening/demarcation and as advertisement and branding media, all in accordance with the drawings, artwork, specifications, and instructions issued by the Contracting Authority.

The Contractor shall be subject to a penalty for delay of €50 per day inclusive of Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays for any delays over the period of performance stated above. The Contracting Authority reserves the right to terminate the contract without notice when the penalties reach a value amounting to 30% of the contract price.

2.3 Specifications

- 2.3.1 **X5 Printed PVC Mesh Fabric Banners (50% Perforation), printed** on one side only.

- 2.3.2 The perimeter hoarding associated with this project **measures approximately 75 linear metres (m)**.
- 2.3.3 The **PVC Mesh Fabric** shall consist of UV-stabilised HDPE knitted mesh manufactured using heavy-duty monofilament thread and shall incorporate approximately 50% perforation / wind permeability. The material shall be specifically suitable for long-term outdoor use and capable of controlling dust and debris whilst providing a minimum 70% UV blockage / shading factor.
- 2.3.4 The mesh fabric shall be white, or another approved base colour as authorised by the Contracting Authority and shall be resistant to tearing, fraying, weathering, and fading under external environmental conditions.
- 2.3.5 **All graphics** and artwork shall be digitally printed in high resolution using premium-grade UV-resistant inks specifically suitable for external applications. Printed surfaces shall be waterproof, fade-resistant, scratch-resistant, and capable of withstanding prolonged exposure to sunlight, rain, humidity, salt-laden air, and wind without noticeable deterioration, bleeding, peeling, or discolouration of both light and dark colours. Mesh fabric shall be printed on one side only.
- 2.3.6 **Printed colours** shall accurately match the approved artwork and submitted digital files. No significant variation in tone, saturation, contrast, or colour shade shall be permitted between the approved artwork and the final printed product. The printed output shall maintain consistent colour quality throughout the entirety of mesh fabric.
- 2.3.7 **The Contracting Authority shall provide the final artwork for printing and implementation.**
- 2.3.8 Each mesh panel shall be supplied complete with sixteen (16) factory-finished reinforced eyelets/grommets suitable for fixing purposes by others. Eyelets shall be positioned approximately 20mm clear from the printed artwork unless otherwise instructed by the Contracting Authority.
- 2.3.9 **Preambles**
1. The rates for printed PVC Mesh Fabric shall be deemed to include the supply and delivery, of all materials, labour, plant, equipment, printing processes, handling, protection, packaging, transportation, and all ancillary items necessary for the proper execution and completion of the works as specified.
 2. The prices and rates inserted in the bill of quantities are to be the full inclusive values of the works described under the items, including all costs and expenses which may be required in and for the execution of the works described together with any temporary works and installations which may be necessary and all general risks, liabilities and obligations set forth or implied in the documents on which the tender is based. It will be assumed that establishment charges, profit and allowances for all obligations are spread evenly over all the unit rates.

3. The rates will cover all tax, duty or other liabilities which are not stated separately in the bill of quantities.
4. The Bill of Quantities (BOQ) shall be read in conjunction with the specifications, illustrations, and all relevant documentation prior to the submission of pricing. No claims for variations, omissions, repeated works, or additional costs arising from the Contractor's failure to do so shall be entertained.
5. The **Contractor shall submit samples and/or print proofs for approval prior to production where requested.**
6. All dimensions shall be verified by the Contractor prior to production and delivery.
7. **Each individual banner shall measure approximately 1.8m x 15m.** The quantity of banners to be supplied shall be calculated accordingly to achieve the required overall perimeter coverage. The total perimeter coverage is indicated in the Bill of Quantities (Qty section).

2.4 Execution Period

- 2.4.1 The time-limit for the execution of the contract shall be **four (4) weeks** from the date of the Purchase Order.

Section 3 Financial Offer

3.1 Financial Offer

The Economic Operator shall fill-in and submit their offer by filling the Form marked as '[Financial Bid Form](#)'. The Contracting Authority reserves the right to disqualify bidders who fail to submit or provide all the requested information requested in the '[Financial Bid Form](#)'.

Economic Operators must quote all components of the price inclusive of taxes/charges, customs and import duties and any discounts BUT excluding VAT. VAT shall be paid in accordance with the current VAT regulations.

3.2 Criteria for Award

- 3.2.1 The sole award criterion will be the price. The contract will be awarded to the bidder submitting the cheapest priced offer satisfying the requested administrative and technical criteria.

The Contracting Authority reserves the right to accept or reject financial offers exceeding the estimated procurement value based on the current market rates.

The Contracting Authority reserves the right to disqualify offers received late even though they might be technically and financially compliant (please refer to the cover page of this RfQ for the respective deadlines).

Furthermore, the Contracting Authority reserves the right to refuse or cancel this RfQ, in part or in full, at its discretion without any obligation.
